WORD GUIDE



Before you begin this activity, you may want to keep this handy word guide with you so that you know what type of word the activity is asking you for. Here we go!

Noun - a person, place, or thing Examples: bear, campfire, marshmallow, tent

Plural Noun - more than one of something (usually add an "s"!)
Examples: raccoons, pinecones, sleeping bags, sticks

Verb - an action word - something you DO Examples: run, jump, wiggle, snore, eat

Verb (past tense) - something you already DID (usually add "ed"!) Examples: jumped, ran, wiggled, snored

Verb ending in -ing - something that is happening RIGHT NOW Examples: running, jumping, wiggling, snoring

Adjective - a word that describes something Examples: slimy, enormous, purple, stinky, fluffy

Adverb - describes HOW something happens (usually ends in "ly"!) Examples: loudly, sneakily, wildly, slowly

Number - any number you want! Examples: 3, 47, 1,000
